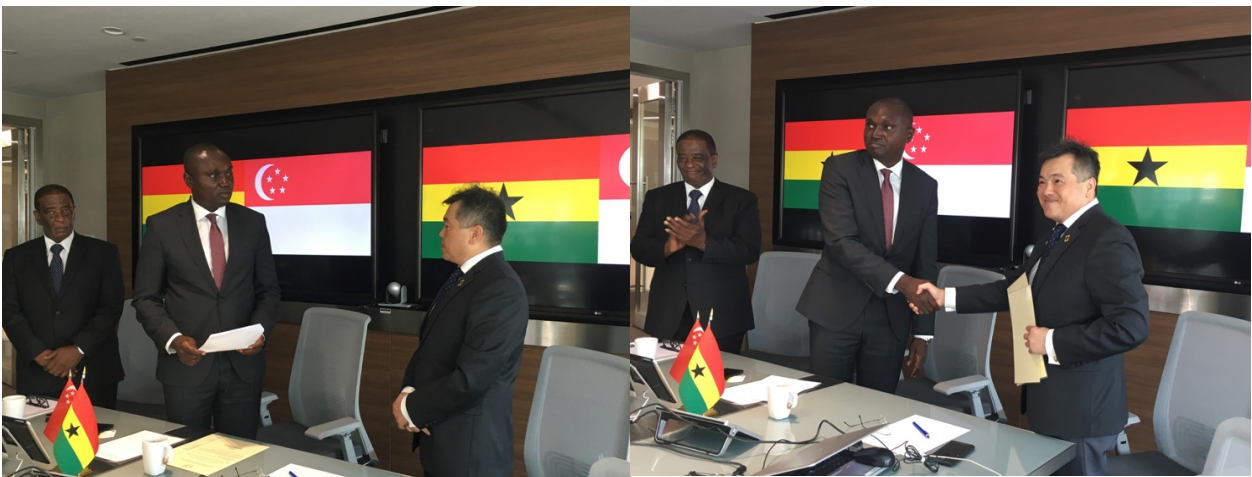


RE-OPENING OF GHANA'S HONORARY CONSULATE GENERAL IN SINGAPORE

The Honorary Consulate General of Ghana in Singapore has been re-opened. The new Honorary Consul, Mr. Andrew Choy, was Commissioned at a brief ceremony chaired by the Deputy Minister for Foreign Affairs of Ghana, Hon. Charles Owiredu, on 26th August, 2018 in Singapore.

At the inauguration event, the Deputy Minister officially handed over the Letter of Commissioning signed by the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Ghana, Hon. Shirley Ayorkor Botchwey, to Mr. Choy.
